This is regarding the 5<sup>th</sup> World Coffee Conference (WCC), 2020 and the meetings of the ICO/ICC to be held in Bengaluru, India during September 2020.

In this regard I may mention that the dates for the said event have been approved to be held from the 10<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> September 2020, with WCC 2020 from 10<sup>th</sup> -12<sup>th</sup> September 2020, 13<sup>th</sup> September 2020 being a Sunday, the meetings of the ICO/ICC to be held from the 14<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> September 2020.

However we have received feed back that it would be more convenient for the delegates to attend the 5<sup>th</sup> WCC 2020 and the ICO/ICC meetings, if the event is organised within a week i.e. from Monday to Saturday. Accordingly, I would request you to consider rescheduling the WCC and the Meetings of the ICC/ICO to 7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> September 2020, with the WCC to be held from the 7<sup>th</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> September 2020 and the meetings of the ICO/ICC to be held from the 10<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> September 2020.

I would be grateful if you could place this request for acceptance by the ICC at its forthcoming meeting in Nairobi, Kenya between 25<sup>th</sup> -29<sup>th</sup> March 2019.
